WEBINAR OVERVIEW

To assure good quality testing, human and animal health laboratories and point of care (PoC) testing sites need to conduct many quality assurance activities and work within a quality management system.


Many countries in the region have implemented some of these activities but few have all the requirements in place, increasing the risk of incorrect results.

NRL Australia has defined a Quality Testing Framework that describes the quality activities that each country should aim to implement to ensure good quality test kits are used correctly by laboratory and PoC testing sites to achieve good quality results. NRL uses this as the basis for their regional capacity building support, which includes training and mentoring that develops strong local expertise.
